Submitting a DMCA Notice:

1. Identification of the copyrighted work that has allegedly been infringed.
2. A description of the location of the infringing material on the website (e.g., specific URL).
3. Your contact information, including your full name, mailing address, telephone number, and email address.
4. A statement under penalty of perjury that you have a good faith belief that the use of the material is unauthorized by the copyright owner or applicable law.
5. A statement that the information in the notification is accurate, and that you are authorized to act on behalf of the copyright owner.
6. Your physical or electronic signature.

Upon receiving a valid DMCA notice, we will:

- Promptly investigate the claim,
- Remove or disable access to the infringing material,
- Notify the responsible party, giving them an opportunity to provide a counter-notification if they believe the material was removed in error.

Submitting a Counter-Notification:

If you believe that your material was wrongly removed, you may submit a Counter-Notification in compliance with the DMCA. The counter-notification must include:

1. Your contact information,
  2. Identification of the removed material and its location before removal,
  3. A statement under penalty of perjury that the removal was a mistake or misidentification,
  4. Your physical or electronic signature.
